10	About & Outcome	About: The Department of English of Santal Bidroha Sardha Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya organized an insightful online webinar titled "Shakespeare in Bengali Theatre: Challenges and Possibilities" on 19- 08-2020 in two Sessions: (Morning & Evening). In the Morning Session the Keynote Speaker was Prof. Bishnupriya Dutt, Professor, School of Arts and Aesthetics Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi and the Guest of Honour was Prof: Abhijit Sen, Professor, Department of English & Other Modern European Languages, Visva Bharati, West Bengal and the Invited Speakers were Dr. Jolly Das, Associate Professor & Head, Department of English, Vidyasagar University, West Bengal & Dr. Samipendra Banerjee, Assistant Professor of English, University of Gour Banga, West Bengal. The Invited Speaker of Evening Session was Esha Yousuf, Eminent Theatre Personality & Film Producer, Dhaka, Bangladesh. It was followed by a Panel Discussion and the Panelists were Chandan Sen, Eminent Theatre Director & Actor, West Bengal Dr. TarunKumar Pradhan, Eminent Theatre Director & Associate Professor, Department of Drama, RabindraBharatiUniversity, West Bengal Arna Mukhopadhyay, Eminent Theatre Director & Actor, West Bengal Arna Mukhopadhyay, Eminent Theatre Director & Actor, West Bengal. The event aimed to explore the adaptation and performance of Shakespeare's works in the context of Bengali theatre, discussing both the obstacles	

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and opportunities inherent in this cultural fusion. The webinar commenced with an introduction to the history of Shakespearean adaptations in Bengali theatre. It highlighted the enduring popularity of Shakespeare's plays and their translation into Bengali, as well as their integration into the local theatrical tradition.

The speakers elaborated on the challenges of translating Shakespeare's language and cultural nuances into Bengali. The webinar fostered an appreciation for the unique blend of Shakespearean drama with Bengali cultural elements, highlighting the richness and diversity of theatrical expression.

The discussions inspired participants to think creatively about how classic works can be reimagined in different cultural contexts, encouraging innovation in their own theatrical endeavors. The interactive session helped build a sense of community among theatre enthusiasts and academics, promoting ongoing dialogue and collaboration. 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
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
